## TLS Logistics Opens an Office at Atatürk Airport

TLS Logistics International Services department is carrying out a new structuring process. As part of this process, which is being carried out in parallel with the company's rapid growth, an office has been opened at Atatürk Airport. Through this office, business is conducted in the vicinity of the cargo terminals.

The TLS Logistics International Services division has been undergoing a restructuring process for some time. TLS Logistics has increased the volume of air transport from imports and exports in the first quarter of 2013 to 350 tons per month.

The goal is to increase the monthly air shipment volume to 550 tons by the end of 2013. TLS Logistics has achieved this volume with shipments to Russia, China, the Middle East, South America, and West Africa. In addition to these figures, the company loads 150 tons per month on the Shenzhen - London, Shanghai - Andorra, and New York - Almaty routes.
